1. 2.	Members of NATRC or immediate family of a person who has been a member of NATRC for a minimum of three years. Members of NATRC or immediate family of a person who has been a member of NATRC for less than three years, but more than six months.
	Scholarships will be given to students in the following order:
1. 2. 3. 4.	Enrolled in any accredited School of Veterinary Medicine in the continental United States. Enrolled in studies leading to a degree in Animal Science, Nutrition, Health and/or other related equine field. Enrolled in other equine related studies in accredited courses; i.e., stable management, equine studies, horseshoeing, etc. Order of consideration: 1st, to college students entering their senior year. 2nd, to college students entering their junior year. 3rd, to college students entering their sophomore year. 4th, to college students entering their freshman year.

Other considerations include character of applicant, academic background of applicant (grades, etc.) and financial need. Please Note: If accepted, you will be asked to include a 3X5 photo (head and shoulders) for publicity purposes.
