Recipients of the Bev Tibbitts Scholarship will be students in the following priority:

- 1. Members of NATRC or immediate family of a person who has been a member of NATRC for a minimum of three years.
- 2. Members of NATRC or immediate family of a person who has been a member of NATRC for less than three years, but more than six months.

Scholarships will be given to students in the following order:

- 1. Enrolled in any accredited School of Veterinary Medicine in the continental United States.
- 2. Enrolled in studies leading to a degree in Animal Science, Nutrition, Health and/or other related equine field.
- 3. Enrolled in other equine related studies in accredited courses; i.e., stable management, equine studies, horseshoeing, etc.
- 4. Order of consideration:
 - 1st, to college students entering their senior year.
 - 2nd, to college students entering their junior year.
 - 3rd, to college students entering their sophomore year.
 - 4th, to college students entering their freshman year.

Other considerations include character of applicant, academic background of applicant (grades, etc.) and financial need.
